Clothing

- ☐ Lightweight, breathable long-sleeve shirts (neutral colors: beige, khaki, green)
- ☐ Lightweight, breathable long pants (neutral colors)
- ☐ T-shirts (neutral colors, avoid bright whites or neons)
- ☐ Fleece jacket or sweater (for cooler mornings/evenings)
- ☐ Waterproof rain jacket or poncho
- ☐ Wide-brimmed hat or cap (with neck protection)
- ☐ Bandana or scarf (for dust protection)
- ☐ Comfortable walking/hiking shoes (broken-in, not new)
- ☐ Sandals or flip-flops (for camp)
- ☐ Socks (moisture-wicking, several pairs)
- ☐ Underwear (quick-dry recommended)
- ☐ Sleepwear (lightweight)
- ☐ Swimsuit (if your safari includes a lodge with a pool)

Personal Items & Toiletries (Part 1)

- ☐ Passport (valid for 6+ months) and copies
- ☐ Visa (if required) and copies
- ☐ Travel insurance documents
- ☐ Credit cards and some cash (USD or local currency)
- ☐ Toothbrush, toothpaste, and dental floss
- ☐ Biodegradable shampoo and soap
- ☐ Deodorant
- ☐ Razor and shaving cream
- ☐ Hairbrush or comb

Personal Items & Toiletries (Part 2)

- ☐ Sunscreen (SPF 30+)
- ☐ Lip balm with SPF
- ☐ Hand sanitizer (small bottle)
- ☐ Wet wipes (biodegradable)
- ☐ Tissues or toilet paper (small pack)
- ☐ Personal medications (with prescription copies)
- ☐ Pain relievers (e.g., ibuprofen, acetaminophen)
- ☐ Anti-diarrheal medication
- ☐ Antihistamines (for allergies)
- ☐ Motion sickness medication (if needed)

Gear & Accessories (Part 1)

- ☐ Daypack or small backpack (for daily excursions)
- ☐ Binoculars (8x42 or 10x42 recommended)
- ☐ Camera with extra batteries and memory cards
- ☐ Camera lens (zoom lens for wildlife, e.g., 70-300mm)
- ☐ Lens cleaning kit
- ☐ Universal power adapter (for charging devices)
- ☐ Portable charger/power bank
- ☐ Headlamp or flashlight (with extra batteries)
- ☐ Reusable water bottle
- ☐ Sunglasses (polarized, with UV protection)

Gear & Accessories (Part 2)

- ☐ Insect repellent (DEET or picaridin-based)
- ☐ First aid kit (bandages, antiseptic, tweezers)
- ☐ Duct tape (small roll for repairs)
- ☐ Multi-tool or Swiss Army knife
- ☐ Lightweight travel towel
- ☐ Notebook and pen (for journaling or notes)
- ☐ Guidebook or wildlife checklist

Miscellaneous

- ☐ Snacks (nuts, energy bars, dried fruit)
- ☐ Reusable ziplock bags (for organizing or trash)
- ☐ Lightweight sleeping bag liner (if camping)
- ☐ Earplugs (for noisy campsites or flights)
- ☐ Travel pillow (for long drives or flights)
- ☐ Book or e-reader (for downtime)
- ☐ Deck of cards or small travel game
